TENACITY develops a digital platform supporting Passenger Information Units (PIUs) and Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) through enhanced data analytics, interoperability and real-time risk assessment for cross-border crime prevention and travel intelligence. The platform enables data-driven decisions, integrates diverse travel-related information sources and fosters cooperation among security stakeholders. - Assessment via interactive quiz

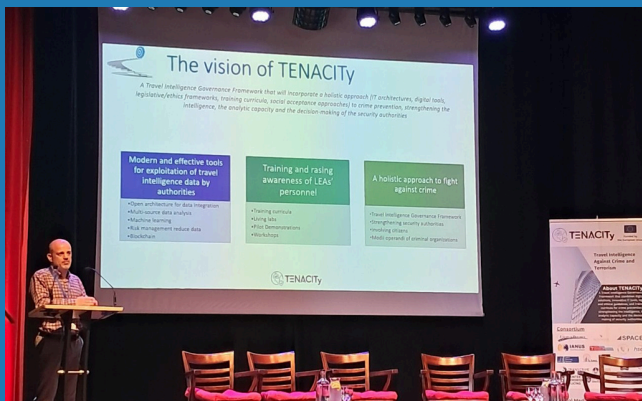


END USER WORKSHOP
